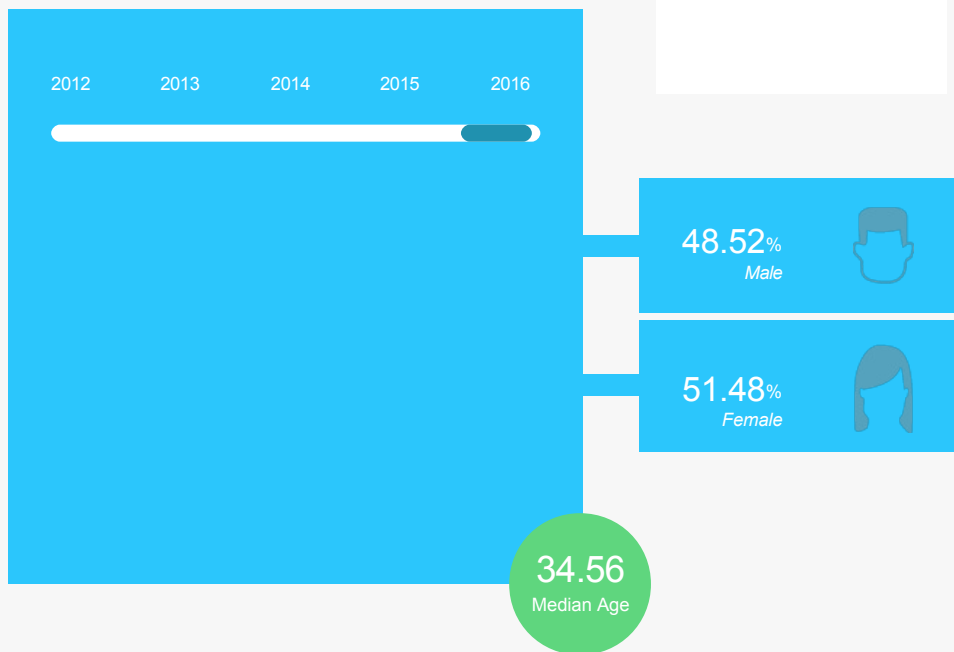

The total population of the City of El Campo is 11,658. The median age is 34.56.



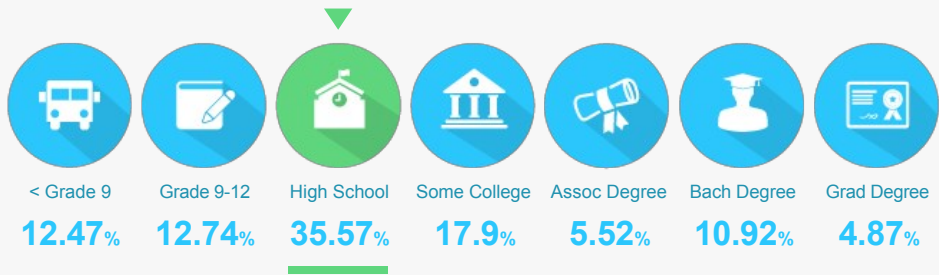
The population in El Campo has grown 0.48% since 2012.

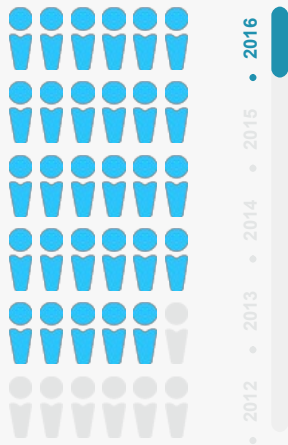

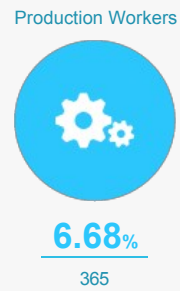
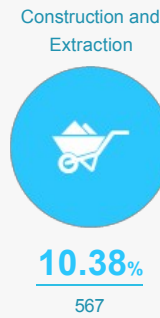

How many employees do businesses in El Campo have?

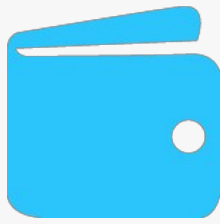

INCOME AND SPENDING

Workers in El Campo earn a median yearly household income of \$48,467. 41.16% of the households earn more than the national average each year. Household expenditures average \$50,850 per year. 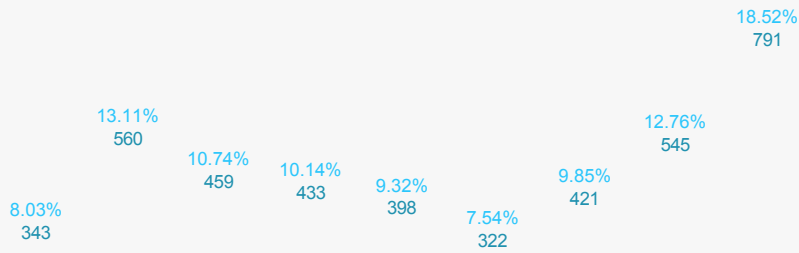

How do people spend much of their money?

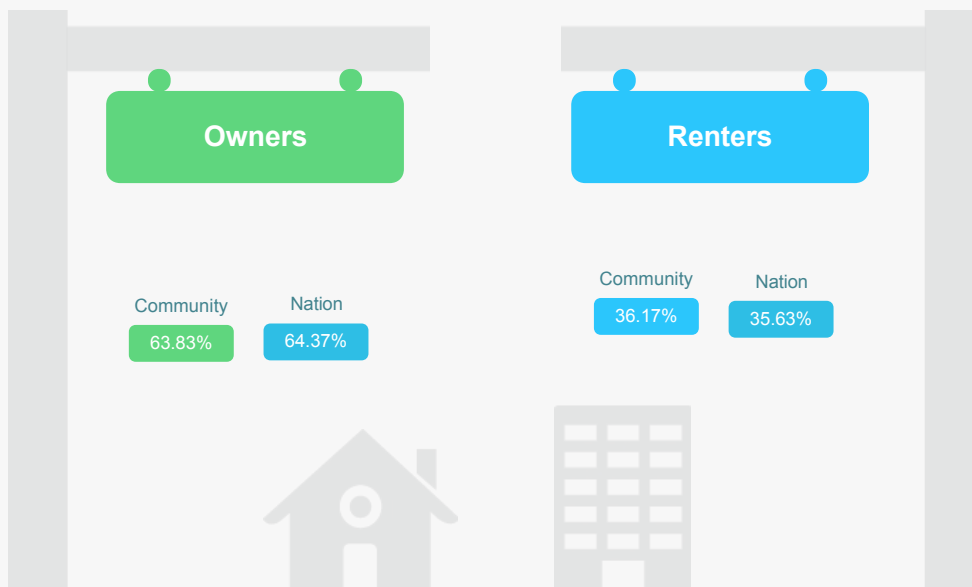
