City Development Corporation of El Campo Job Creation/Retention Incentive Program

2022-2023 Threshold Requirements

Local Job Creation/Retention:

All jobs are based on full-time equivalent jobs and require Board approval, and City Council approval if the amount is \$25,000.00 or over. The amount of incentives will vary, based on the project, on a case-by-case basis. The total incentives for a project will be determined by the CDC Board of Directors.

The CDC may award job creation incentives based on the following criteria:

Hourly Wage

Incentive

\$13 - \$18.99 per hour

Up to 8%

Example: 15 Employees at \$15.00/hour for 2080 hours = \$468,000

 $468,000 \times 8\% = 37,440$ maximum eligible incentive

amount

\$19 - \$23.99 per hour

Up to 10%

Example: 15 Employees at \$21.00/hour for 2080 hours = \$655,200

 $655,200 \times 10\% = 65,520 \text{ maximum eligible incentive}$

amount

\$24 + per hour

Up to 12%

Example: 15 Employees at \$25.00/hour for 2080 hours = \$780,000

\$780,000 x 12% = \$93,600 maximum eligible incentive

amount

Job Creation Incentive payments will be paid on the 1 year anniversary date of funding approval. Funding amount will be based on the number of <u>Full Time Equivalent</u> employees, listed on a State or Federal payroll reporting form, for the 4th quarter following approval.
